Home Inspection Preparations

To make the inspection process as smooth and efficient as possible, please help by doing the following, as applicable:

- 1. Ensure Inspector has access to all areas of the home, carport and/or garage.
- 2. Have the electricity, gas and water on.
- 3. Have large pets, or ones that are prone to escape, restrained.
- 4. Have any items that are leaning against the exterior of the house removed.
- 5. Have blinds or curtains open so we can more easily check the operation of the windows.
- 6. Have any gates unlocked.
- 7. Have the crawlspace door/access accessible. We will close it after the inspection.
- 8. Have the garage door(s) unlocked, or keys available.
- 9. Make sure the spaces in front of the water heater, furnace and electrical panel are unobstructed.
- 10. Make sure the area below the attic access hatch(es) is(are) clear since we will be placing a ladder there. If it is from the garage, the car(s) may need to be outside.
- 11. Please have as many electrical outlets as possible unobstructed so we can check them.
- 12. If the house has a whole-house automatic generator, please leave it unlocked for the day, and assume we will simulate a power outage, which may require you resetting some clocks.
- 13. Please dis-arm alarm systems/notify monitoring companies as necessary.
